Caroline Jean Carver, 56, of Cheyenne, died on Thursday, August 23, 2018 in Aurora, Colorado, from complications during heart transplant surgery.

She was born on February 19, 1962 in Cheyenne.

Caroline was formerly the Children's Ministry Director at First Presbyterian Church. She was very active in the church and a volunteer with the CFD Indian Committee.
